

What you need:

- A printer
- A pair of scissors (All children should be supervised)
- Paper glue stick
- Any embellishments (such as sequins, netting, feathers etc.)
- A ruler (if needed)
- A protective mat or board
- Small cardboard box or backing card to create a scene (optional)

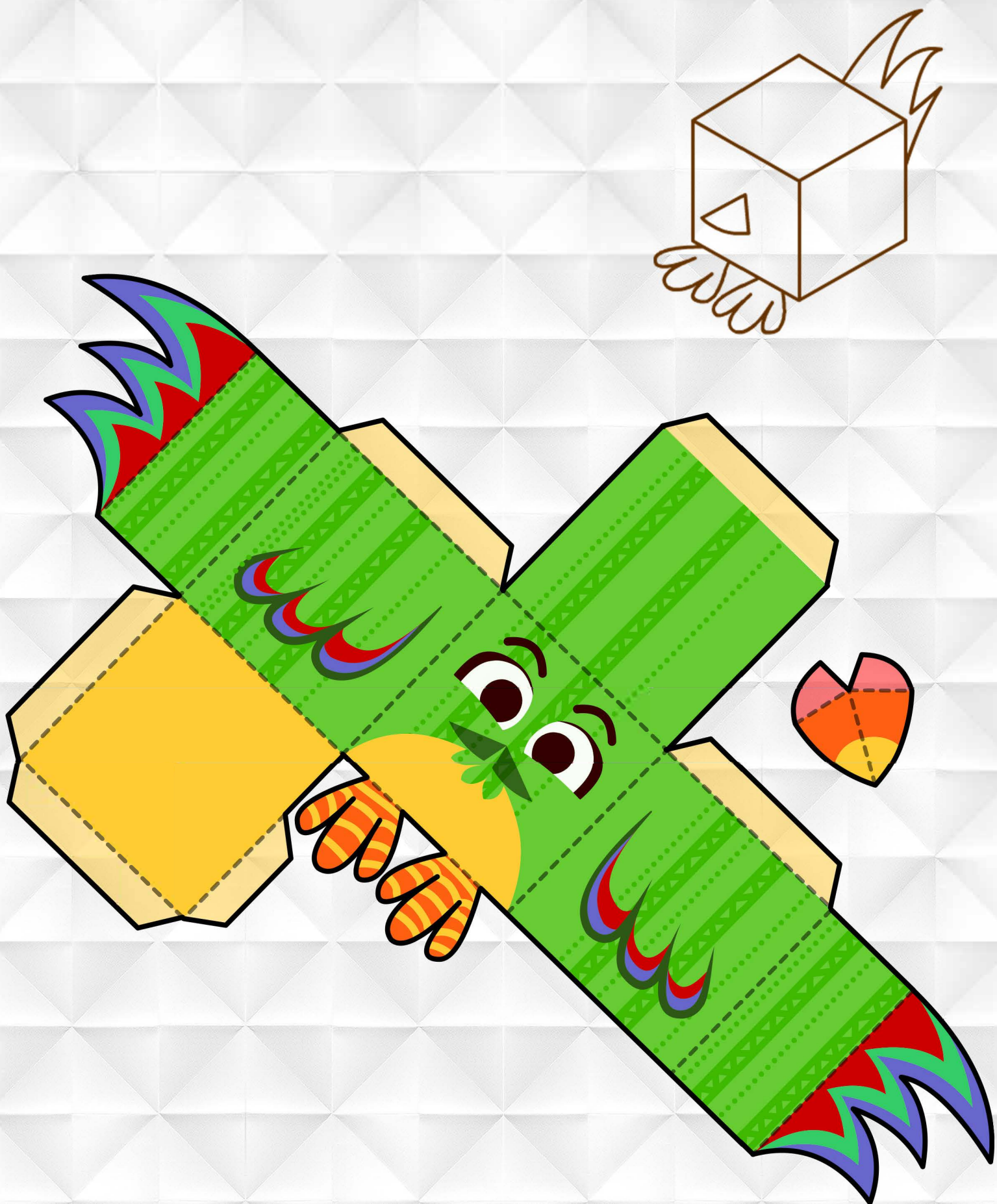
Instructions:

1. First of all download the desired paper toy template in either full colour or black and white and print.
2. Carefully take the scissors and cut out all the template shapes along the bold black line. Make sure you have an adult to help you. Place the cut out pieces on the protective mat or board.
3. Use the ruler and scissors to gently score along all the black dotted lines to make them easy to fold.
4. Assemble your paper toy by gluing the flaps to the inside of the body.
5. Create a scene for your paper toy to sit in using a cardboard box or backing card (optional)

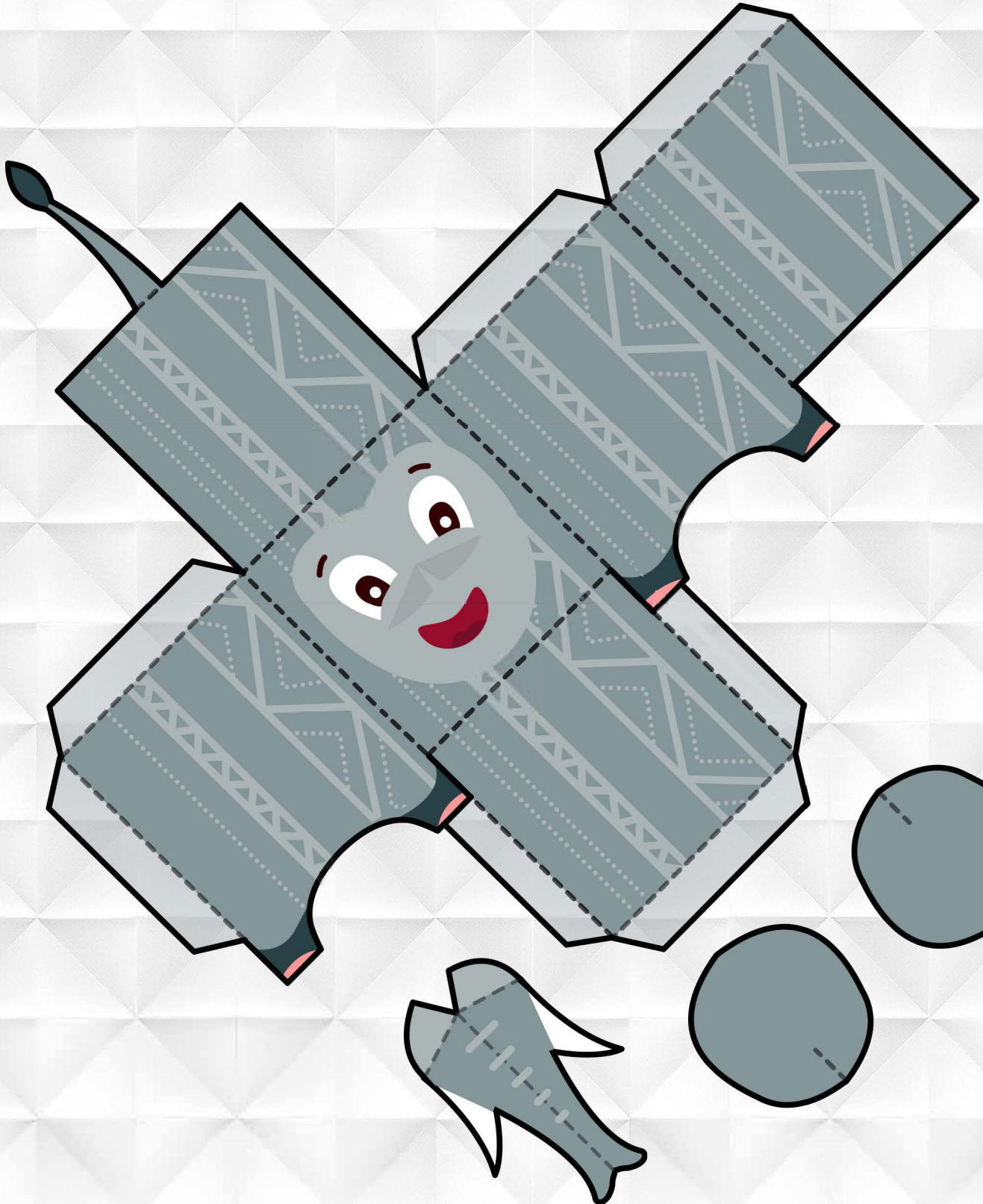
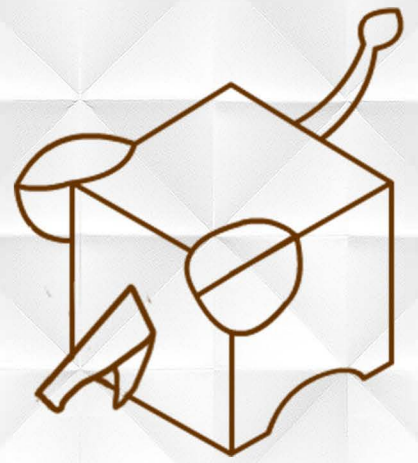
